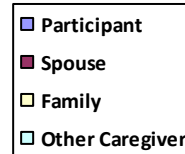
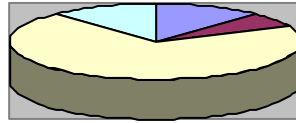


2016 HIAC Survey Results

Hilo Adult Day Center Survey for current Participants and Families

We received 48 responses for a response rate of 44%.

- She doesn't remember anything, but seems happy and content when I pick her up.
- Great treat it is open Saturdays for family needs.
- Thank you very much.
- We no longer care for our loved one at home, but we went through all the stages. First she attended HIAC when she was still living alone and we brought her to HIAC. She then lived with us and stayed at HIAC while we worked. Then the Alzheimers got too bad and we needed to put her in a private care home since now we have health issues of our own and still travel to babysit. Through it all HIAC is great. Even if she is in a care home we still have to HIAC because it is good for her. One day we will be there ourselves!
- Suggestion: Having participants standing and moving should be on regular basis and schedule at intervals throughout the day.
- While I would be interested in the Sun Downing Program, the isolated location of the center raises security concerns.
- I enjoy the activities very much and all the nice people I now call my friends and I feel safe.
- Mel helps me a lot with exercise, mahalo for that! Bronson is awesome, I miss him bathing me he makes everything fun and he's so good at his job! I appreciate him so much, he is a 10! Kalei is wonderful too, nice to talk too.
- I hope to be able to attend Adult Care for many more years.
- I like that staff is there to pick up participant in the morning, also they help to send him off in the afternoon. They're very helpful.
- When we were able to bring her to HIAC, we enjoyed a welcome few hours of respite. We found that hiring an aide to come to our home once a week was much more appropriate for our needs because even if my mom had a health problem someone came and gave us a break. Our aide also cleaned her bedroom, fed her lunch, and bathed her. This only cost us about \$35 more for the same 5 hours. For other people who don't need 8 hours of care/respite, I would highly recommend this alternative. The aide comes once a week and she is wonderful.
- Exercise or stretching. Afternoon napping.
- Thank you, Thank you, Thank you. I wouldn't be able to go to work if it wasn't for HIAC. This place gives me a peace of mind knowing that my mom loves it here and waits anxiously every morning to come to her second home!

How can we improve the quality of our services?

- I just read in an article from Mt.Sinai school of medicine that regular exercise or physical activity protects against cognitive decline. Those who cannot attend or do physical activity should walk around at the very least.
